## IMPORTANT NOTES

- Uniform Reminder
  - Socks should be plain black or white
  - Cold Weather
    - Plain sweatshirt/sweater (black, gray, royal blue)

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## A LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Romero Academy at Resurrection Families,

As part of our goal to prepare scholars for success in high school, college, and beyond it is our responsibility to provide all of scholars with an opportunity to receive an academically excellent education.

To meet this goal, we closely examine student academic growth using a national assessment from the Northwest Education Association called the Measures of Academic Progress (aka NWEA MAP).

This test allows us to compare students' academic results to grade-level peers across the country. More importantly, this test allows us to gain a precise understanding of each student's academic strengths and weaknesses and then create learning opportunities that meet each student's individual needs.

NWEA MAP is administered in the fall, winter, and spring in both reading and mathematics. Each test takes approximately 1 hour.

There is nothing specific that your student needs to study in order to prepare for this test, but please make sure your child:

- Gets a good night's rest the night before the test
- Eats a healthy breakfast before testing, and
- Gets to school on time

Please also encourage your child(ren) to give their best effort and to take their time on each test. If students show up late, miss test dates, or rush through the test, it slows down our process for making individualized learning opportunities for your scholars.

Once testing is complete, we will share results with you.

Kinder-5<sup>th</sup> Grade, please park in the gravel lot


